**OFFICE ORDER**

Following representation by various CGHS beneficiaries for issue of Inj. Tresiba (Inj. Degludec) and Inj. Victoza (Inj. Liraglutide) a meeting of experts was held under Chairpersonship of Director, CGHS. The Committee members unanimously opined that: -

**"The Committee was of the opinion that these drugs (Inj. Degludec and Inj. Liraglutide) have not shown superiority over existing drugs available in CGHS formulary for glycaemic control (Diabetes Mellitus). Long term cardiovascular safety is lacking. The Committee was of the opinion that these drugs cannot be approved at present".**

This issues with the approval of Competent Authority.
